

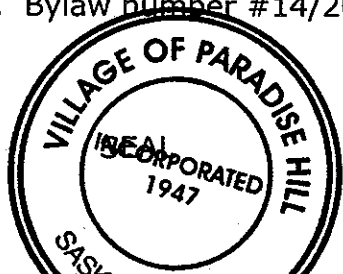
VILLAGE OF PARADISE HILL

BYLAW # 06/2014

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF PARADISE HILL TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR CONSUMPTION OF MUNICIPAL WATER AND THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR SEWER RENTAL.

The Council of the Village of Paradise Hill in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enact as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known and may be cited as the "Water and Sewer Rates Bylaw" of the Village of Paradise Hill.
2. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water services have been turned on shall be those set forth in Schedule "A" hereto, or as amended from time to time; provided, however, that the minimum shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed.
3. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are, by Bylaw, required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services, a rental rate or service charge in accordance with Schedule "B" hereto, or as amended from time to time.
4. All persons with water or sewer service connections in billing shall pay an infrastructure charge in accordance with Schedule "C".
5. Accounts for water service and/or sewer service shall cover a period of one month, and shall be rendered on or before the first day of the month next following such period. Accounts shall be paid within a period of thirty days from the date on which such accounts are rendered. If any account is not paid within thirty days of the account being rendered, the water service may be cut off.
6. When the water service is so cut off, it shall not be resumed until all arrears have been paid, together with a fee of \$40.00 to cover the expenses of turning the water off and turning it on again; provided that if the Village is required to turn on the said water service before 8:00am, after 6:00pm, or on a weekend, the fee may be \$50.00.
7. If the water supply is shut off from the premises of a user for infringement of the provisions of this bylaw, same shall not be turned on until all penalties, fees, rates, charges, and arrears, if any, have been paid.
8. Water meters shall be read once every month.
9. The portion of any account remaining unpaid after a period of thirty days following the date on which the account was rendered, shall be subject to interest charges totaling 2% of the unpaid balance, per month.
10. The rates, charges, tolls, or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee, or on January 1, 2015, whichever is later.
11. Bylaw number #14/2013 is hereby repealed.

0 to 1000 X # occupied units	\$25.00 minimum charge X # occupied units
1000 X # occupied units to 9,999,999	\$0.0175 per gallon

SCHEDULE "C"
TO BYLAW #06/2014**

1. An infrastructure charge of \$15 per month will be billed to each property with a water or sewer service connection in billing.
2. Multi-unit residential complexes (including condominiums, apartments, seniors housing complexes) shall be charged one infrastructure charge (\$15.00) per occupied unit per month.
