National Volunteer Week April 27-may 3 "Volunteers Make Waves" highlighting the impact of individual and collective volunteer efforts.

Spring Thaw Tips:

Spring not only brings warm temperatures it also brings the threat of flooding, with melting snow or heavy snow and rains.

Some tips to help mitigate potential problems:

- Shovel snow from around your foundation.
 Allow the water to drain away from your home.
 Take special notice around basement window sills.
- Take notice of any developing ice ridges that are building and chip them down to allow drainage.
- Clear eavestroughs and roof of excess snow.
 Extend downspouts if possible, at least 6 feet from the foundation. Protect against ice damming.
- Do not shovel snow onto the street or pile on the sidewalk.
- Check to make sure your sump pump is working to pump out any water that makes it to your sump.

It is important to be considerate of your neighbors and work with them to prevent water from being drained onto each other's properties.

Be a Responsible Pet Owner!

- License your Dog
- Pick up after your pet. Dog & Cat waste is a health and environmental hazard
- Don't let you dogs/cats roam onto other peoples property

Dog License Fees: All dogs in the Village are required to have a license.

- -\$35 for a new dog licence.
- -\$35 for renewal Jan 1 Feb 28. After Feb 28 renewal fee is \$40.00.

CATS: The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. They don't require a license.

Development/Building Permits:

All applicable permits are required to be in place before any work has been started.

Did you know many common improvements to your property may require a permit such as:

- New builds (Fence, shed, garage or dwelling)
- Demolitions, repairs or alterations to an existing structure
- Moving structures on or off your property
