Pet Owners:

- License your Dog
- Pick up after your pet. Dog & Cat waste is a health and environmental hazard
- Don't let you dogs/cats roam onto other peoples property
- Dog License Fees: All dogs in the Village are required to have a license
- -\$35 for a new dog licence.
- -\$35 for renewal Jan 1 Feb 28. After Feb 28 renewal fee is \$40.00
- Dog Bylaw #02/2016 can be found on the Village website under "Governance."

CATS: The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. They don't require a license.

Development/Building Permits:

Does your next construction project require a permit?

Many common improvements to your property may require a permit:

- New builds (Fence, shed, garage or dwelling)
- Demolitions, repairs or alterations to an existing structure
- Moving structures on or off your property

All applicable permits are to be in place before any work has been started.

Property Tax Discounts for 2025:

Discounts are applied to the municipal portion of property taxes, for taxes paid on or before:

October 31: -2%

November 30: -1%

Please Note:

Taxes not paid by December 31 will have a 10% penalty added on January 1, 2026.
