### **Property Tax & Water Bill Payment Options:**

The Village offers multiple payment options to assist residents in paying their taxes and water bills in a timely manner.

#### **Payment Options include:**

- In Office cash, cheque or debit
- Synergy Credit Union online banking system
- E-transfer to [paradisehill@sasktel.net](mailto:paradisehill@sasktel.net)
- Annual or monthly automatic debit from any bank or credit union. (Authorization forms are available at the Village Office)

### **Water Bill Email Option:**

**We offer residents the option to have their water bill emailed to them instead of mailed.**

### **Summer and Water Consumption:**

Residents typically see an increase in their water bills during the summer months, increased consumption comes from watering lawns, gardens or filling swimming pools or ponds. High consumption also comes from leaking toilets, taps, dishwashers, washing machines, or more people staying or living at your home, using more water. A leaking toilet can use 100's of gallons of water and is usually the main reason for large steady increase in high water consumption. The Village office will contact you if we notice any increase in consumption when we are reading water meters.

### **Village Safety:**

### **Pet Owners:**

- License your Dog
- Pick up after your pet. Dog & Cat waste is a health and environmental hazard
- Don't let you dogs/cats roam onto other peoples property

**Dog License Fees: All dogs in the Village are required to have a license.**

-\$35 for a new dog licence.

-\$35 for renewal Jan 1 - Feb 28. After Feb 28 renewal fee is \$40.00.

**Dog Bylaw #02/2016 can be found on the Village website under "Governance."**

**CATS:** The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. They don't require a license.

### **Development/Building Permits:**

**Does your next construction project require a permit?**

Many common improvements to your property may require a permit:

- New builds (Fence, shed, garage or dwelling)
- Demolitions, repairs or alterations to an existing structure
- Moving structures on or off your property

**All applicable permits are to be in place before any work has been started.**

### **Property Tax Discounts for 2025:**

Discounts are applied to the municipal portion of property taxes, for taxes paid on or before:

**August 31: -4%**

**September 30: -3%**

**October 31: -2%**

**November 30: -1%**

#### **Please Note:**

Taxes not paid by December 31 will have a 10% penalty added on January 1, 2026.
