-\$35 for a new dog licence.

-\$40.00 per dog for late renewals

Reminder – Fire Department False Alarm and Fire Fees

If your security system triggers a call to the Paradise Hill Fire Department and it turns out to be a false alarm that does **not require fire-fighting services**, the following fees will apply:

- **Less than 1 hour on scene, no service provided:** \$400.00
- **1 hour or more on scene, no service provided:** \$850.00
- **Fire-fighting services provided:** \$1,129.82 per hour

If the Paradise Hill Fire Department responds to your property and requires assistance from a **neighboring fire department or third-party contractors**, any fees or charges from those departments or contractors are the responsibility of the property owner. Fees from the Paradise Hill Fire Department are waived. Please ensure your insurance covers these potential costs and fees.

Please ensure your security systems are properly maintained to avoid unnecessary charges and fees.

2025 Property taxes unpaid as of January 1, 2026 are subject to a 10% penalty. A penalty rebate of 2% is available on the municipal portion of any tax arrears paid before April 30, 2025.
