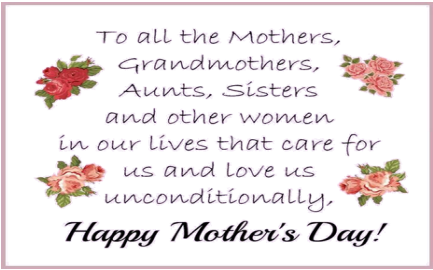

2021 Property taxes unpaid as of January 1, 2022 are subject to a 10% penalty. A penalty rebate of 1% is available on the municipal portion of any tax arrears paid before May 31, 2022. Property tax can be paid through the Synergy Credit Union online banking system.

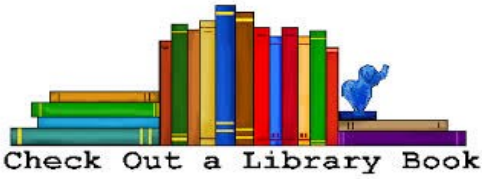

Civic Address & Emergency Response: The Village encourages all residents to have a house number displayed.

Why is it important to have a civic address/house number displayed on your property?

Take a moment to drive around after the sun has gone down and try to find a particular address that is unknown to you. It is not very easy. Emergencies can happen to anyone, anywhere, at any time – including during a blizzard or in the middle of the night.

Displaying house numbers aides emergency services in locating your residence or property in a more efficient and faster response time. As most emergency services are dispatched from out of town, ambulance or rescue personnel would not be familiar with the Village.

The Village is encouraging all residents to install house numbers or re-examine existing house numbers. Ideally house numbers should be displayed beside the main entrance of a building or residence under a light, in a size and color that is easily visible from the street. They should not be obstructed by shrubs, trees, decorations, etc. If they are not on a building but at the end of a lane way it should be clear as to which property is being represented.

Saskatchewan Lotteries Community Grant Application:
