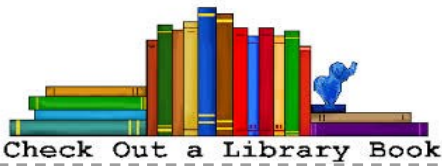
911 SERVICE:

What do our taxes pay for?

Residents taxes fund services including police and fire services, education and health services, libraries, road maintenance, clean drinking water and continued updates to water and sewer lines. Property taxes increase proportionately with the value of your property. Your tax notice will include both municipal and school taxes. Provincial legislation requires all properties in Saskatchewan be revalued once every four years.

Responsible Pet Ownership:

All dogs in the Village are required to have a license. Dog Bylaw #02/2016

Fees: \$35 for new/renewal prior to Feb 28. \$40.00 for renewal after Feb 28. Dogs are required to have new tags every year.

There is no by-law regarding Cats. Be respectful of others property and don't let your cats dig in other peoples flower beds or roam all over town.

Tax Discounts:

Discounts for early payment of taxes will apply as follows:

For taxes paid on or before:

July 31-5%

August 31-4%

September 30-3%

October 31-2%

November 30-2%

Taxes that are not paid by December 31 will have a 10 % penalty added on January 1.
