For taxes paid on or before:

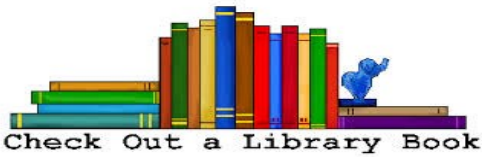
November 30-1%

Development/Building Permits:

Are you considering improvements to your property? If you are building, renovating or moving a building all applicable permits are required to be in place before starting.

Development and building permits are available at the Village Office.

Water and Tax Bills - Payment Options:

Online banking is available through any Credit Union. When paying your water bill or taxes through the online banking system with the Credit Union, make sure to use the proper account number. For Water Bill payments, use the 11 digit account number that appears in the top right corner of your bill. For tax payments use your tax roll number.

Etransfer: etransfers can be sent to paradisehill@sasktel.net

CAFT: Is a monthly automatic debit of the bill amount. CAFT can be used to pay for water bills and for taxes.

Authorization is required and forms are available at the office.

Cash, Cheque and Debit are also accepted. We do not offer Credit Card Payments.

Wipes Clog Pipes:

With the increased use of wipes and paper towels, we remind residents to please put these items in your trash and do not flush down the toilet.

- Wipes snag on any imperfection in sewer pipes, catch passing debris and grease, and create a "ball" that will grow to plug the pipe. **They also get drawn into sewer-line and wastewater treatment plant pumps and clog and damage them.**
- **The "Flushable" Wipes Myth:** Flushable Wipes are often marked as an alternative for cleaning and claim to be "Flushable" and "Sewer Safe" they are not as they do not break down.

Wipes Clog Pipes!

Place these items in the **TRASH** and **NOT** the toilet:

- Disinfecting wipes
- Paper towels
- Baby wipes
- Towelettes
- Mop refills
