Snow Removal:

We ask that residents not park any trailers, campers or extra vehicles on the streets to aid in the timely manner of snow removal. If you have a sidewalk by your property, please make sure that it is cleared of snow and ice.

2023 Winter Season the Village will not be plowing personal driveways or yards.

Frozen Water Lines:

It is residents responsibility to make sure they are using enough water to keep lines from freezing.

Is your home/rental vacant during the winter? Make sure it is checked frequently. The Village will not thaw out water lines.

Reading Water Meters:

Do you know where your meter is located in your home?

It's important to make sure that it is not blocked or tampered with so it can be read. Water meters in the Village are read via radio meter. We do not require access to your dwelling. If the meter shows an error or a high water consumption, we will contact you to check if you have a water leak.

Slow leaks in toilets account for most high water readings. In the summer months, watering gardens and filling swimming pools also account for high readings.

Dog Licence Fees: \$35 for new/renewal prior to Feb 28. After Feb 28 fee is \$40.

All dogs in the village are required to have a license. New tags are required each year .

CATS: The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. If you own a cat, please be respectful of other's property.

Property Tax Penalty/ Discounts:

2022 Property taxes unpaid as of January 1, 2023 are subject to a 10% penalty. A penalty rebate of 4% is available on the municipal portion of any tax arrears paid before February 28, 2023.
