Be a Responsible Pet Owner:

- License your Dog
- Pick up after your pet. Dog & Cat waste is a health and environmental hazard
- Don't let you dogs/cats roam onto other peoples property

Dog License Fees: All dogs in the Village are required to have a license.

- \$35 for a new dog licence.

- \$35 for renewal Jan 1 - Feb 28. After Feb 28 renewal fee is \$40.00.

Dog Bylaw #02/2016 can be found on the Village website under "Governance."

CATS: The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. They don't require a license.

Property Tax Penalty/ Discounts:

2022 Property taxes unpaid as of January 1, 2023 are subject to a 10% penalty.

A penalty rebate of 1% is available on the municipal portion of any tax arrears paid before May 31.
