Property Tax Discounts:

Discounts are applied to the municipal portion of property taxes: For taxes paid on or before:

August 31-4%

September 30-3%

October 31-2%

November 30-1%

Taxes not paid by December 31 will have a 10 % penalty added on January 1, 2024

Property Tax & Water Bill Payment Options:

The Village offers multiple payment options to assist residents in paying their tax and water bills in a timely manner.

Payment Options include:

-In Office cash, cheque or debit

-Synergy Credit Union online banking system

-E-transfer to paradisehill@sasktel.net

-Annual or monthly automatic debit from any bank or credit union. (Authorization forms are available at the Village Office)

Water Bill Email Option:

We also offer residents the option to have their water bill emailed to them instead of mailed.

Be a Responsible Pet Owner!

- License your Dog
- Pick up after your pet. Dog & Cat waste is a health and environmental hazard
- Don't let you dogs/cats roam onto other peoples property

Dog License Fees: All dogs in the Village are required to have a license.

-\$35 for a new dog licence.

-\$35 for renewal Jan 1 - Feb 28. After Feb 28 renewal fee is \$40.00.

Dog Bylaw #02/2016 can be found on the Village website under "Governance."

CATS: The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. They don't require a license.

Paradise Hill Campground:

-6 electrical Campsites: \$25.00 per night

-Overflow is non electrical: \$20.00 per night

-First Come First Serve Basis: Reservations not accepted

-Summer Bash Campers are required to pay for campsites

What Do Your Property Taxes Pay For?

Residents taxes fund services that include police and fire services, education and health services, libraries, road maintenance, clean drinking water and continued updates to water and sewer lines. Property taxes increase proportionately with the value of your property. Your tax notice will include both municipal and school taxes. Provincial legislation requires all properties in Saskatchewan be revalued once every four years.

Development/Building Permits:

Does your next construction project require a permit?

Many common improvements to your property may require a permit:

- New builds (Fence, shed, garage or dwelling)

-Demolitions, repairs or alterations to an existing structure

-Moving structures on or off your property

All applicable permits are to be in place before any work has been started.
