Property Tax & Water Bill Payment Options:

The Village offers multiple payment options to assist residents in paying their tax and water bills in a timely manner.

Payment Options include:

- In Office cash, cheque or debit
- Synergy Credit Union online banking system
- E-transfer to paradisehill@sasktel.net
- Annual or monthly automatic debit from any bank or credit union. (Authorization forms are available at the Village Office)

Water Bill Email Option:

Development/Building Permits:

Does your next construction project require a permit? Many common improvements to your property may require a permit:

- New builds (Fence, shed, garage or dwelling)
- Demolitions, repairs or alterations to an existing structure
- Moving structures on or off your property

All applicable permits are to be in place before any work has been started.

Wipes Clog Pipes:

The use of wipes is a convenience that we all use, however they do not break down and belong in the trash because:

- Wipes snag on any imperfection in sewer pipes, catch passing debris and grease, and create a "ball" that will grow to plug the pipe.
- Wipes get drawn into sewer-line and wastewater treatment plant pumps and clog and damage them
- **The "Flushable" Wipes Myth:** Flushable Wipes often claim to be "Flushable" and "Sewer Safe" they are not as they do not break down
- Place these items in the Trash and NOT the toilet:
 - Disinfecting wipes, paper towels, baby and makeup wipes, or mop refills
