Winter Snow Removal:

The Village reminds residents to remove any campers, trailers and extra vehicles from the streets and back alleys to help facilitate the removal of ice and snow in a timely manner during the winter months.

If you have a sidewalk by your property, it would be appreciated if you would keep your sidewalk clear of ice and snow to make it safe for residents to walk.

Water Lines Freezing:

It is the responsibility of each Village resident to ensure that they are using enough water to prevent water lines from freezing. If you are away from home for any period of time, have someone check your home and turn on taps and run the water for a short period of time.

The Village will not thaw out water lines.

Reading Water Meters:

Do you know where your meter is located in your home?

It's important to make sure that it is not blocked or tampered with so it can be read. Water meters in the Village are read via radio meter. We do not require access to your dwelling. If the meter shows an error or a high water consumption, we will contact you to check if you have a water leak.

Slow leaks in toilets account for most high water readings. In the summer months, watering gardens and filling swimming pools also account for high readings.

Be a Responsible Pet Owner!

- License your Dog
- Pick up after your pet. Dog & Cat waste is a health and environmental hazard
- Don't let you dogs/cats roam onto other peoples property

Dog License Fees: All dogs in the Village are required to have a license.

- \$35 for a new dog licence.

- \$35 for renewal Jan 1 - Feb 28. After Feb 28 renewal fee is \$40.00.

CATS: The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. They don't require a license.

Development/Building Permits:

Does your next construction project require a permit?

Many common improvements to your property may require a permit:

- New builds (Fence, shed, garage or dwelling)
- Demolitions, repairs or alterations to an existing structure
- Moving structures on or off your property

All applicable permits are to be in place before any work has been started. For more information on permits and fees contact the Village Office.
