Be a Responsible Pet Owner!

- License your Dog
- Pick up after your pet. Dog & Cat waste is a health and environmental hazard
- Don't let you dogs/cats roam onto other peoples property

Dog License Fees: All dogs in the Village are required to have a license.

- \$35 for a new dog licence.

- \$35 for renewal Jan 1 - Feb 28. After Feb 28 renewal fee is \$40.00.

CATS: The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. They don't require a license.

Development/Building Permits:

Does your next construction project require a permit?

Many common improvements to your property may require a permit:

- New builds (Fence, shed, garage or dwelling)
- Demolitions, repairs or alterations to an existing structure
- Moving structures on or off your property

All applicable permits are to be in place before any work has been started.

Updated Information Required:

In our ongoing effort to make sure that Village residents are receiving tax notices ,water/sewer billings and other correspondence from the Village, we are asking residents to please advise the office of any address and phone number changes. If you are on the CAFT payment system and have changed banking information, new authorization forms are required to be updated and signed. If you wish to be contacted via email, please provide your email address.

New Walking Path:

The Village has a new walking path on the Northwest side of the Village near the ball diamonds through the spruce bluff. There is a small red sign marking the entrance to the path.
